Livestock Committee - Policy and Catalog Changes 2017

1. All Animal show pages we will add the following sentence:

Animals must be in good health, if there are any concerns then subject to be checked by Macon County Fair Board approved Veterinarian. If animal is diagnosed as sick by the approved veterinarian then the Macon County Fair Board has the sole right to ask the owner/exhibitor to remove animal from the property.

2. Animal check in will be from 9:00am – **8:00pm**
3. Checks will be written out to exhibitors unless the animal is shown by 4H or FFA.

1. Line #1 change: Must not have reached the age of 19 by the date of the show. Exhibitor must be able to exhibit on their own without any help.
1. Line #2 change: Steer must be fed 150 days before show date. Animals will need to be pre-registered 90 days before the start of the fair to be shown. (June 15, 2017)
2. Line #3 change: Steers need to be a minimum weight of 1,000lbs to be shown in the Market Steer show.
3. At the bottom at showmanship: max age will be changed from 20 to 18

2. Line #1 change: Must not have reached the age of 19 by the date of the show. Exhibitor must be able to exhibit on their own without any help.
3. Line #2 change: Steer must be fed 150 days before show date. Animals will need to be pre-registered 90 days before the start of the fair to be shown. (June 15, 2017)

Pg. 33 Market Hogs Page

1. Line #1 change: Must not have reached the age of 19 by the date of the show. Exhibitor must be able to exhibit on their own without any help.
2. Line #2 change: Pigs must be owned and fed by exhibitors at least 90 days before show date. Animals will need to be pre-registered 90 days before the start of the fair to be shown. (June 15, 2017)
3. Line #3 change: Each exhibitor is limited to two entries.
4. Line #4 will stay same – minimum weight of 200lbs – If an animal is under 200 lbs, it will not be shown in the Market Hog Show.
5. At the bottom the showmanship age will change from 20 to 18.
