2022 Macon County Fair:

Wed. Sept. 21 – Sat. Sept. 24

Dear Macon County Fair Exhibitor and Family:

The pre-registration form for 2022 is enclosed and **it is due June 15<sup>th</sup>**

NEW THIS YEAR:

1. Due to the hog barn septic needing repairs, the hog check-in will be 4pm – 5pm Friday September 24. The show will be at 6:30pm Friday September 23. After the show hogs can be taken home. If the hogs will be auctioned at the sale Saturday night then you will need to leave your hog overnight Friday.
2. Beef cattle check-in will be different this year. IF you want to display your animal in the barn during the week of the fair then please do. Make an appointment with Devon Deal, Jenny Collins or Ronnie Norton if that is your plan. Otherwise beef cattle check-in will be 7am – 8am Saturday Sept. 24. Shows starting at 10am.

Hog reminders: hogs have to be a minimum of 200lbs to be shown in the market show. If the hogs weigh less than 200lbs they will not be allowed to go through the market hog auction. The exhibitor must be able to exhibit on their own, IF they do need help then another exhibitor can assist them.

Cattle reminders: To be in the “fat calf steer” show the animal must weigh more than 1,000lbs. For cattle please remember, the exhibitor must be able to exhibit on their own, IF they do need help then another exhibitor can assist them.

Dr. Jessica Scruggs will be on site to check animals for illness before they are put in barns. The state is tightening up health regulations for fairs and it is important for all animals to be healthy so no illness can be spread to others.

Thank you again for all the hard work you put in to making our county fair such a success each year!!
