## **Rules & Regulations**

- 1. Open to Junior exhibitors under 21 years old, all of whom must be a Macon County resident.
- 2. Goats must be fed and cared for by exhibitors at least 60 days before show date.
- 3. Show is open to all breeds of goats. Goats must be free from disease.
- 4. Goats must be does, wethers or nannys (no billies to be shown, billies for exhibit only).
- 5. Limit to two entries per exhibitor. Class size will be limited to 12 head.
- 6. Goats will be shown on halter. Goat show will be best of class.
- 7. Goats will remain on display at Goat Barn for duration of Fair.
