Rules & Regulations

1. Open to junior exhibitors who have not reached the age of 19 by the date of the show. Exhibitor must be able to exhibit on their own without any help.
2. Steer must be owned and fed by exhibitors at least 150 days before show date. Animals will need to be pre-registered 90 days before the start of the fair to be shown. All steers must be shown by owner. Each exhibitor is limited to two entries per breed.
3. All steers must grade good, choice or prime and fed grain for at least 150 days. All steers are subject to the mouthed when unloaded to determine eligibility and show class identification. Steers can have two permanent teeth, all other teeth must be baby teeth in place. Steers need to be a minimum weight of 1,000 to be shown in the Market Steer show. If the steer weighs from 751 lbs. to 999 lbs. it would fall in the intermediate class. This class will use the guidelines of the JMS feeder calf show. They will not be allowed to enter into the auction on the Saturday night of the fair due to that being a strictly large steer auction. For it to be in the auction the steer has to be over 1,000 lbs.
4. The entries (over all breed) will be divided into weight groups. Steers must be halter broken and dehorned.
5. All steers will be ear-tagged and weighed between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on the Tuesday of the fair week by a Fair Board member. No re-weigh allowed.
6. Exhibitors will feed and care for their animals during the fair until animals are turned over to their buyer or taken back home Sunday when the fair is over.
