Procedures

Division A and B: All exhibits must be the work of the youth and must have been made since the last Macon County Fair. For Division A, there is no size limit on 3-D art but flat art must be 12" x 8" or smaller.

Judging procedures and criteria for Division B will be the same for the adult divisions, however, all will receive a blue, red, or white ribbon based on quality. All rules for exhibitions will apply. Rosettes will be awarded for Division B (9-18).

All photos are to be matted or mounted, and/or framed. A standard mat or mount should be used; no flimsy poster board or cardboard. The name, address, and phone number of the photographer are to be on the back of the mat or mount so that no name is visible on the front of mat or mount before judging. The number of entries will be limited to one per person, per category. Print size can be no smaller than 5" x 7", and no larger than 8" x 10". Mat or mount size no larger than 11" x 14". No oval mats.
