Rules & Regulations

- 1. Open to junior exhibitors who have not reached the age of 19 by the date of the show. Exhibitor must be able to exhibit on their own without any help.
- 2. Pigs must be owned and fed by exhibitors at least 90 days before show date. All pigs must be shown by owner. If they do need help then another exhibitor can assist them. Animals will need to be pre-registered 90 days before the start of the fair to be shown.
- 3. Each exhibitor is limited to two entries.
- 4. Each animal must weigh a minimum of 200 pounds. The entries will be divided into weight groups. If an animal is under 200 lbs. it will not be shown in the Market Hog Show. If the hogs weigh less than 200 lbs., than the hogs can only be shown in the showmanship classes and they will not be allowed to go through the market hog auction.
- 5. All hogs will be ear-tagged and weighed on Tuesday of the fair by a member of the Macon County fair board from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- 6. Exhibitors will feed and care for their animals during the fair until animals are turned over to their buyer or taken back home when the fair is over.
